Abstract Submission Information

- Abstracts may be submitted for a short talk (10 minutes) or poster presentation.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English using the online Abstract Submission Link below.
- Notifications on the status of submitted abstracts will be sent to the presenting author by **January 15, 2012**

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Before you start the abstract submission process, please read and prepare all necessary information detailed below.

The on-line Abstract Submission Form includes the following parts:

Part 1: Presenting author's (use full first name and last name)

Part 2: Authors

- The name of the presenting author will automatically appear as the first author
- Insert only the names of the additional authors in the order that they should appear in the abstract. You will be able to change the order of the presenting author, if needed.
- Use full first name and last name of all authors.

Part 3: Affiliation/s (Institution/s)

- Insert name of institution, department, city (state, if relevant) and country. After each institution entered, check the box/es of author/s associated with that institution.
- Make a separate entry for each institution. Do not repeat identical institution details if they apply to more than one author.
- Text should be in Upper and Lower Case.
- Do not abbreviate Department, Institute, University, etc.
- In the department field, type in the words "Department of..." If relevant, as only the words you type in will show on the abstract.

Part 4a: Presentation type

- Short talk or Poster presentation (contributed abstracts).
- Invited lecture (to be selected by invited speakers only).

Part 5a: Abstract Title – limited to 25 words. Use CAPITAL LETTERS.

You will be required to type in your abstract title (do not copy & paste).

Part 5b: Abstract body

- Abstract body (including references) should not exceed 250 words.
- Copy & paste your abstract into the abstract area or type it in directly.
- Tables may be inserted in black/white only and must be saved as JPG, GIF or PGN and uploaded as an image, OR edited directly by the editor.
- *Most important:* Proofread your abstract (including title) and insert/format special characters which were not saved in the copy & paste process. You should then click "Submit".
- **Submission Acknowledgement** – After you click Submit", a system "End Message" will indicate that the abstract was successfully submitted. You will then be able to "**Preview**" your abstract and modify it, if needed by using the "**Update**" link. In that case, click SUBMIT again.
- **E-mail Acknowledgement & Abstract Number:** Following submission your abstract, you will receive by e-mail an automatic detailed submission acknowledgement with your abstract number and a link to access your abstract (should you need to view/revise it again).

System Information

The abstract submission system is designed to run on many internet browsers, but we recommend that you use the latest versions of Microsoft Internet Explorer (v.8.0), Google Chrome 5, or Firefox (v3.6 or better). *DO NOT USE SAFARI* .
