

Sigal Bar-Zvi was born in Israel in 1969.

Commander Bar-Zvi enlisted in the Israel Police in 1991 and served in an undercover unit in the Central Unit of the Central District.

She continued her service in a number of positions including Human Resources, Operations Officer and Head of the Traffic Division of the Sharon Sub-District. She was later appointed as Commander of the Ra'nana Police Station **as one of the first women to be a police station commander.**

In July 2009, she was appointed Commander of the North Tel Aviv Police Station and in 2012 as Commander of the Petah Tikva Police Station.

In September 2013 Commander Bar-Zvi was appointed to be the Commander of Ben Gurion International Airport Sub-District. She is the first woman in the Israel Police to be appointed as Commander of a Sub-District.

In 2014, during the Arab riots and terrorist activities, she was appointed to head one of the operational command centers in Jerusalem.

In 2015, she studied for a year in the prestigious National Security Academy.

In August 2016 she was appointed as Commander of the Ayalon Sub-District of the Tel Aviv District.

Commander Bar-Zvi has a B.A. in Business Administration and an M.A. in Policy and Government.
