Iris Dotan, MD, is Head of the Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) Center at The Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center in Tel Aviv, Israel, a tertiary referral center for IBD patients. Prof Dotan received her MD from the Sackler Faculty of Medicine, Tel Aviv University in Tel Aviv, Israel. She is is a specialist in internal medicine, gastroenterology and liver diseases. Her postdoctoral fellowship was at the Immunobiology Center at Mount Sinai Medical Center in New York, USA, focusing on mucosal immunology and intestinal epithelial cell biology. Prof Dotan has specific expertise in the use of biologics and novel therapies for IBD, and the follow-up of patients with ulcerative colitis before and after restorative proctocolectomy (pouch surgery) in a comprehensive, multidisciplinary pouch clinic. She first described the new antiglycan antibodies and their relevance to Crohn's disease.

Prof Dotan has more than a hundred peer-reviewed publications and book chapters. Amongst her positions are: President Elect of the Israeli Gastroenterology Association, a councilor for the IBD Section of the AGA, and a member of the executive committee of the IOIBD.
