Dr. Matti Waterman is a staff gastroenterologist at the Rambam Health Care Campus, Haifa, Israel and is director of the Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) Service at the Department of Gastroenterology at Rambam. He received his M.D. with honors from the Technion – Israel Institute of Technology, Faculty of Medicine. He graduated with honors the residency program in Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology at Rambam.
