Václav Havel Airport Prague

- Frequent and rapid bus connections taking only 30 minutes to arrive to the city centre. 69 airlines connect Prague to 162 destinations around the world. For more information visit www.prg.aero.
- Airport city connection:
- Bus lines connecting Terminals 1 and 2 with the metro A ("Nádraží Veleslavín", then bus 119) and B lines ("Zličín" then bus 100).
- Airport express directly connects the airport and the main railway station (enabling direct access to the metro C line and international and local train lines.)



Prague metro lines

- The whole underground network is divided into the three main lines, each represented by its own color:
- <u>Line A</u> (green)
- <u>Line B</u> (yellow)
- <u>Line C</u> (red)
- Intervals
- metro operates daily 5:00am midnight
- · two to three minutes between trains during peak hours
- four to nine minutes in off peak hours (after 7:00 pm).
- There are 57 metro stations with 3 important transfer stations – Muzeum (red to green), Mustek (yellow to green) and Florenc (yellow to red). To get from one station to another takes about two minutes.
