Abstracts Submission Deadline: April 30, 2018

Abstract Submission Information

- Abstracts must be submitted in English using the online Abstract Submission Link below.
- Each presenting author may submit only one abstract.
- Abstracts will be published on the Society's website. Submission of the abstract constitutes the authors' consent for such publication.
- **ISM Membership Fee - 2018:** to be paid by the presenting author by **April 30, 2018**, the abstracts submission deadline. This is required in order to ensure that an abstract will be considered for presentation at the meeting.
- Notifications on the status of submitted abstracts will be sent to the presenting author by **May 17, 2018**

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Authors

- The personal details listed in the abstract form must be those of the presenting author.
- Use full first name and last name of all authors

Presentation Type:

- Short talk – 15 minutes
- Poster presentation
- Invited lecture (to be selected by invited speakers only)

Abstract Title:

Insert up to 25 words, in CAPITAL LETTERS

Abstract body

- Limited to 275 words including references (fewer if a figure/table is included).
- Abbreviations must be defined upon first use and avoided in the title.
- Copy & paste your abstract into the abstract area or type it in directly.
- Images, tables may be uploaded in JPG, GIF or PNG format. Please note that each image included equals to approx. 35 words. Images should be of up to 500kb.
