The 4th Resolution Days meeting: A Vibrant Gathering of Minds in Inflammation Research

The 4th Resolution Days Meeting was held in Frankfurt from April 8th-10th 2025 as a joint event with the iiSIAR Forum. It brought together over 120 experts and students from around the world to discuss current controversies and new developments in the field and form new and meaningful connections. An inspiring line-up of talks covered new aspects of formation and action of specialized pro-resolving lipid mediators and the role of regeneration, metabolism and aging during the resolution of inflammation and tissue repair, as well as translational aspects. Scientific excellence was highlighted by 15 EFIS travel fellowships and 8 SLB prizes for young researchers. The atmosphere buzzed with energy - whether in the packed lecture hall, or over coffee breaks - and the outstanding attendance underscored the field's growing impact - a resounding success on every front! 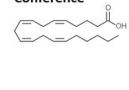
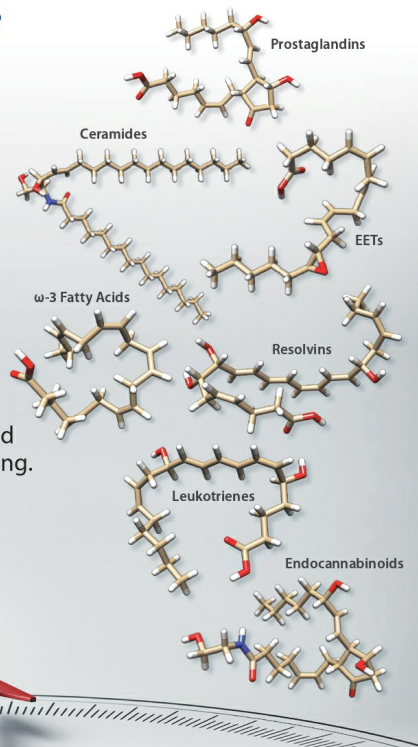
