In honour of the Rothschild Prize in Chemistry awarded to Prof. Uri Banin (The Hebrew University of Jerusalem), Yad Hanadiv invites research and PhD students to participate in a seminar and apply for an Excellence Award.

Researchers from all Israeli universities in the field of nanomaterials, their physical and chemical properties, and their applications are encouraged to apply.

The accepted papers will be presented as posters as part of the symposium and will receive exposure, comments and clarifications from international experts in the field. Three Excellence Awards of NIS 5,000 each will be announced at the Rothschild Prize Symposium.
