



Over the past decade, a journalist has been killed on average every four days. In addition, close to 9 out of 10 cases of killings of journalists remain judicially unresolved according to UNESCO data. When a journalist is attacked, society as a whole pays the price, as freedom of expression and access to information, which are bedrocks of modern societies, erode away. In order to foster a free and safe environment for media workers, UNESCO and the IAP have entered into cooperation to strengthen the role of prosecutors to fight against impunity for crimes and attacks against journalists.
