



The Advisory Committee of Co-Operation States (ACCS) Meeting 6 November 2019, Tel Aviv, Israel

INFORMATION NOTE

1. BACKGROUND

ECMWF has 12 co-operation states. The ACCS draws up, for the submission to the council, opinions and recommendations on the program of activities and the budget of the center, on items relevant to co-operation states, and on any matter submitted to it by the council.

The 25th session of the ECMWF Advisory Committee of Co-operating States (ACCS) which will be held in Tel Aviv, Israel, on 6 November 2019. This meeting has been scheduled to take place after the ICSEED meeting on 4 November and the SEE-MHEWS-A meeting on 5 November.

2. DATES AND VENUE

The ECMWF Advisory Committee of Co-operating States meeting will be held on 6 November 2019 at the Crowne Plaza Tel Aviv Beach Hotel (address: 145 Hayarkon Street, Tel Aviv) hosted by the Israel Meteorological Service (IMS).

5. TRANSPORTATION

The airport is located about 30 km from Tel Aviv.

There are two major ways to get from the airport to Tel-Aviv:

Special Taxi: You are requested to order a taxi through the taxi dispatcher only. The dispatcher post is located in Level G (ground level), at the exit from Gate 03 of the terminal. Price: about 120-140 NIS (~25-35€), depends on the time of the day.

<u>Train and taxi</u>: The train station is located outside the terminal. Tel-Aviv has four railway stations, the most recommended for your purpose is either "Hashalom" station (on your way out of the station, do not get into "Azrieli" mall, which is located in one of the exits) or Savidor-Center. Please keep in mind that once arriving to Tel-Aviv, you should take a taxi from the railway station to the hotel.

General Note: On Saturday (Shabat), which begins on Friday afternoon and ends on Saturday evening, there is no public transportation (buses and trains). Also, please note that on Friday there are no trains from the airport, however there is a free shuttle from to the Tel-Aviv Savidor-Center station. Taxis are available regularly all week long.

Price: The train from the airport to Tel-Aviv is about 15 NIS (~3.5€); a taxi from the railway station to the hotel is about 30-50 NIS (~7-10€)

6. RESTAURANTS AND SHOPS

During the Shabat (from Friday afternoon until Saturday evening), some restaurants and most shops are closed. Some grocery stores around the city are open 24/7 (including on Saturday).

If you need a pharmacy, the pharmacy on the corner of Dizingoff st. and Gordon st. is open on Saturday.
